

## Curriculum: Level 300 for Students



## Objective

- 1. Follow moderately complex lines of argument provided the topic is reasonably familiar and can recognize signpost words and phrases.
- 2. Identify the key steps in a recording of a process in order to recount them.
- **3.** Follow and complete an outline format to take notes on essentials (main ideas, key points or steps) of lectures, talks, reports.
- 4. Understand lengthy instructions in his/her field or study.
- 5. Identify the context and relevance of information from different types of texts.
- 6. Interpret graphs, tables, charts and maps that illustrate information in a written text.
- 7. Understand text-referring words.
- 8. Obtain information from specialized sources within the field or study.
- 9. Engage in extended conversation on most general topics in a clearly participatory fashion.
- 10. Express his/her ideas and opinions with precision, present and respond to complex lines of argument convincingly.
- 11. Use intonation for emphasis and understand symbols from the International Phonetic Alphabet.
- 12. Give a clearly developed.
  - 13. Write clear, detailed descriptions on a variety of contemporary topics.
  - 14. Write a review of a film, book or play.
  - 15. Summarize information and arguments after reading or listening to a text dealing with a contemporary topic.
  - 16. Use basic pre-writing techniques to gather information for writing an essay.
  - 17. Write a paragraph essay with appropriate organization.
